This free event takes place on the night *after* Halloween (November 1st) and gives the community an opportunity to show off their creative designs and display their jack-o-lanterns for *all to see* one last time!

At the end of the evening, pumpkins can be gathered up by local farmers to use as feed. Any remaining pumpkins will be composted courtesy of **Harnden Haulage**, facilitated by the Municipality of Port Hope.

Save the date, and bring your pumpkins out to shine one last time on Lent Lane in Downtown Port Hope!

Bring your carved pumpkins (with a tea light or LED candle) to Lent Lane between 3:00 pm and 5:30 pm on Friday, November 1st. Volunteers will be onsite to help guide you.

When you arrive for pumpkin drop-off, volunteers and signage will be onsite to help guide you between 3-5:30 pm. If you need to bring your pumpkin(s) sooner, follow the signage and place your pumpkin in a row along the lane.

While this annual event is free to attend and hot chocolate is complimentary, pay what you can (pwyc) donations to Critical Mass are greatly appreciated to support our efforts to bring free arts experiences and programming to the community. We will also have a booth set up at the end of the parade with early-bird Goose Ball Tickets, Critical Mass memberships, and merch.

## **PUMPKIN PARADE / VIEWING:**

6:00 p.m.-8:30 p.m.

The viewing of the lit pumpkins runs from 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

To manage a safe distance for all community members, viewing of the pumpkins will be facilitated in one-direction only, starting at the Little Station in Lent Lane and working your way north to Walton Street.

Follow the pumpkin parade route from the Little Station, and spill into 'The Enclave' at the end of the row (across from the Tiny Station free library at Furby House Books).

The parking lot behind the former Walton Hotel and RONA Stage will welcome parade goers and offers additional programming and an opportunity to connect with friends and neighbours, including:

He is a Recipient of the NASA Exceptional Service Medal (1997), three NASA Space Flight Medals (1984, 1996, 2000), and eleven Honorary Doctorates. Mr. Garneau was named a Companion of the Order of Canada in 2003, served as Chancellor of Carleton University from 2003 to 2008.

**Murray McLauchlan** is one of Canada's most highly regarded singer/songwriters, and with good cause. Over a



50-year career, he has released 20 albums and been awarded 11 Junos. His songs *Farmer's Song*, *Down by the Henry Moore*, *Whispering Rain* and *Sweeping the Spotlight Away* are now considered Canadian standards. Murray is also a painter, an author, an actor, a radio host; he's been bestowed an Honourary Doctor of Laws and appointed to The Order of Canada. That's quite a ride. For many years Murray's touring had been restricted to *Lunch At Allen's*, whose members also include Ian Thomas, Marc Jordan and Cindy Church. But with the release of his critically acclaimed *Hourglass*, he's back on the road treating concert goers to a seamless blend of old and new.

Here's what he has to say: "As a songwriter I know that it's not enough to sit in your kitchen and write. Your songs need to be heard. Music is a communicative art and if it isn't brought in front of people there is no way to tell if that end has been met. I like to think of a concert tour as a kind of roving gallery to test your art and your ideas. I try to do my very best to make it worthwhile for folks to be there and to perhaps look at things in a new way when they leave."

And this, in a nutshell, is the **Murray McLauchlan** concert experience.

Encaustic painting is a technique that involves using heated beeswax mixed with pigments to create art. The word "encaustic" originates from the Greek word "enkaustikos," meaning "to burn in." This ancient method dates back to at least the 5th century BC and was notably used by Greek artists for portraits and panels.

In encaustic painting, beeswax is melted and mixed with colored pigments. The resulting mixture is applied to a surface, typically wood or canvas, in layers using brushes or other tools. Each layer is fused to the previous one with heat, usually by using a heat gun or blowtorch. This process allows for the creation of textured and multi-dimensional artworks with a luminous quality.

Beeswax serves as both a binder and a preservative in encaustic painting, providing durability and protection to the finished piece. The versatility of encaustic allows artists to experiment with various techniques such as collage, embedding objects, incising, and scraping to achieve unique and expressive results.

Encaustic painting offers artists a wide range of possibilities for artistic expression, from delicate and translucent layers to bold and sculptural textures. It continues to be a popular medium for contemporary artists seeking to explore the rich history and unique qualities of beeswax as a material.
